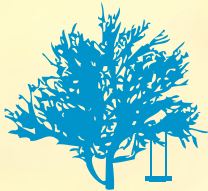

On April 17th 2021, we moved into Stoddard Johnston Family Scholar House. Family Scholar House has had a tremendous impact on me both, personally and professionally. By utilizing the program's resources, I have gained networking and career experience, personal awareness of self-care and access to resources to improve my health, education guidance. Most importantly, I have gained the tools and knowledge to become the best parent I could be. My son has been able to grow up in a safe, comfortable, and loving environment which all children should have access to. Thanks to all of the love and support we have received from the Family Scholar House staff; my son will have so many great childhood memories that I wish I would have had.

The stability provided by FSH has allowed me to be more active in variety of student clubs and organizations. I have been very involved serving as a Vice President of Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) Student Chapter, UofL Ambassador CardinOLL Coach and as a TRiO Adult Student Mentor. I know that being involved will allow me to meet new people, give back to others, and help develop my own professional identity. Spotlight: Dreams & Success

I was born in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and moved to the United States with my family when I was 17 years old. Adapting to a new country has come with many challenges but I have had people who have helped me through it. I knew I wanted to grow up to help people, the same way others had helped me.

I found out I was pregnant right before my senior year of college. I was struggling in a chaotic environment which led to difficulty navigating school and daily life. The struggles and hardships I faced during my pregnancy brought me into Family Scholar House (FSH). I realized I needed family more than ever. I knew moving into FSH would be an excellent opportunity for me because I would be able to focus on my education and care for my son, Kevin.

Family Scholar House provided me with safe, affordable housing, and social workers and success coaches to help me navigate being a student and a parent. That has allowed me the opportunity to do well in my coursework and actually plan for my career while also caring for my son. Before moving in with FSH, I wanted to drop out of college but FSH made it possible for me to earn my Bachelor's degree in social work. I just couldn't
